The book is confrontational, in that it asks us to "dream big... and commit to act in our daily life on what we have dreamed of." (p.6). The context of his new book centres around the current global COVID crisis in which we are all a part of. I thought that as the year progresses I would share with you some of his wisdom to ponder. The first is that:



"The basic rule of a crisis is that you don't come out of it the same. If you get through it, you come out better or worse, but never the same." (p.1)

I think this rings true for Jesus at his crucifixion, death, burial and resurrection. He moves from the human to the divine - to the 'Christ'.

Does this same quote ring true for you? Maybe take a moment and think of; What have been the better 'crises' in your life? What have been the harder ones? What have been the noticeable changes in your life?

Pope Francis talks about this time of reflection as a necessary part in understanding the situation we find ourselves a part of. He urges us to re-think our priorities regarding 'what we value, what we want and what we seek', and understand how our past experiences, strengths and weaknesses shape our future decisions.
